### We are not on track for a 1.5°C above pre-industrial level (Climate Transparency Report)

What does it means to us, Indonesia?

More uncertainty and climate change impact such as extreme weather, flooding, drought lead to displacement.

Climate change is having a disproportionate impact on people, the **most vulnerable** and those suffering the most are those least responsible for it.

- Access to Resources
- Governance
- Culture
- Knowledge and Information

#### Climate justice:

- Uneven impacts of climate change and Human Rights
- Keeping global temperature rise to 1.5°C above pre-industrial level

#### What we need to do:

- Learning from real life experiences of those at the frontline of Climate Change esp. from those vulnerable, marginalised and often left behind in policy making.
   Climate Change is not just about NUMBER, it is about human's life and our future generation!
- Equality and Inclusion at the heart of Just transition! Climate mitigation and adaptation strategy should include local people participation (giving them ownership to the agenda, prevent conflict)
- Transformation is needed! Efforts need to focus on climate justice to ensure that any climate actions and planning are not only focused on climate adaptation or mitigation, but also simultaneously improving the lives of the most vulnerable and oppressed/marginalised
