IESR is seeking an experienced and dynamic individual to perform delivery work for a new project on "Just Energy Transition and Economic Transformation in Coal Producing Region".

About the Project

IESR seeks to work with provincial government of South Sumatera, one of four coal provinces in Indonesia. Coal provinces are prone to adverse impacts of coal decline trend, and the subsequent economic shift is important to address early on. By working with South Sumatera government, we aim to ensure just energy transitions in the province by facilitating multi-stakeholder policy dialogue for the acceleration of renewable energy transition and assisting sub-national governments, local organizations, and impacted communities to take stronger commitments and actions for the transition, support plans for the shift from a coal-focused economy and ascertain inclusivity in the policymaking landscape.

Duties and Responsibilities

The project will run for 14 months starting December 2022, with 2 additional months for reporting and evaluation. The Local Project Officer will be responsible for operational delivery of the project, liaising directly with the Project Coordinator and relevant stakeholders in South Sumatera, and contributing to project communication and outreach strategy.

Requirements

- Minimum bachelor's degree of energy- or engineering-related disciplines (such as industrial engineering, environmental science/engineering, energy engineering, other relevant engineering major), economics, business management, or political science from reputable universities.
- A minimum of 2 years working experience, particularly in the energy sector, public policy, or community development.
- Having good network with government, communities, academia, or civil society organizations in South Sumatera is an advantage.

- Good management and leadership skills.
- Able to complete the contract within the prescribed time.
- Located in Palembang or willing to relocate to Palembang for the duration of project (IESR does not offer relocation fee).
